Overview: We are at the end of Sandy's series revisiting Project Reach, our church commitment to reaching our community for Christ the general theme is: "Let's Reach". In prior weeks, Sandy talked about the why, how and who of reaching out. This week the focus is "when". Think you know the answer?

General Question: Did you ever forget an appointment or an important task or event and had to scramble at the last minute to cover or make up for your mistake? Not an anniversary or a birthday of course, no one has ever done that, but something where you suddenly felt that pang of horror and remorse and had to try to fix it? How did you do? Did you recover in time? Tell us the story. The names of the people or the events aren't important, just how you recovered or maybe you didn't recover. In my case (Dave Otto), I forgot I was supposed to speak to a group of 200 parents at a high school event when I was 15. I remembered as the parents began to file into the auditorium. My stomach sank to my knees. Remind me to tell you what happened. But what is your story?

Pray: Before you begin, ask the Holy Spirit to aid you in this study and that you might see Jesus more clearly as a result. He will provide for you.

Discussion Questions:

1. If Project Reach is a commitment and call to reach out to others, why is the "when" element important? Does it really make a difference when we reach out with the good news of the gospel? Why or why not? Explain. Use scripture to support your answer if you can.
