



Becoming a Small Group Leader FAQ

What is needed?

Willingness - A small group leader is someone who is willing to open their home to others, to create community, fellowship, and grow deeper in relationships with others and with Christ.

Teamwork - Find a good co-leader or co-lead couple. Once your group has begun meeting weekly, identify someone or a couple who might make a great co-leader, able to host/facilitate your small group.

Training - Attend our annual Small Group Leader Training and learn how to do it, or join a current group and serve as a co-leader for a season before leading your own group.

How do I host a group?

You get to decide how you want to host your group. You can meet at your home or share hosting with others in your group. You can also form your group around shared activities and interests (i.e., hiking, cooking, etc.).
