Youth Ministry Cell Phone Policy

Cell Phone for the purpose of this **policy**: The term **Cell Phone** is defined as any handheld electronic device with the ability to receive and/or transmit voice, text, or data messages.

Students will be required to submit their cell phones upon arrival at designated ministry locations. Cell phones will be locked away under the supervision of Desert View Directors for the duration of the trip. Cell phones will be returned to the students in the vans or other transportation during the return trip home.

Students will be encouraged to bring their own cameras apart from their cell phones. Their leaders will be taking photographs during the duration of camp. Phone numbers of the Leaders and Directors will be provided beforehand if the need to contact a child should occur. Likewise, if students are required to contact home, they will have access to use their Leader's cell phones with permission.

This policy is designed to encourage a sense of community while at camps, mission trips and other events without the distraction that social media brings. It also will help avoid potential hazards that technology in our culture can create and to protect the quality time that your child is spending to develop their relationship with God.

Youth Ministry Drug Policy

Desert View Youth Ministry has a zero-tolerance approach towards drugs and alcohol. This includes the new trend of vaping. Vaping contains high concentrates of nicotine which is an addictive drug. If students are found with substances or paraphernalia, they must turn them over to the Youth Director. A phone call will be made to the parents to notify them of the situation and a parent will need to make arrangements to pick up their student from camp.

Violation of the Drug Policy could result in suspension of future trips with the Youth Ministry.
