

We're Resuming Services! (Here's What You Need to Know)

We are excited to host in-person worship services at Desert View once again!

In order to ensure a safe worship environment and reduce the likelihood of disease transmission, we have enacted the following guidelines:

- Due to social distancing protocols & limited space in worship center during construction, **services will be limited to 200 attendees**. Click [HERE](#) to reserve your free admission tickets!
- If you are feeling sick or are in a high risk category, **please stay home** and enjoy our service online.
- We ask that everyone **maintain social distancing guidelines** and remain at least 6' apart from everyone else who is not a member of your household.
- We ask that all attendees please take standard precautions, such as **washing** hands frequently, **using** hand sanitizer, **sneezing** into your elbow, and **refrain** from close personal contact such as hugging or handshaking with those outside your household.

Here are some additional measures we are taking:

- There will be **no nursery, kids, youth or adult elective ministries offered**. Of course, your whole family is welcome to join us for worship!
- No paper bulletins will be passed out.
- Receptacles for tithes/offerings will not be distributed during services. Online giving will still be encouraged and the offering will be collected at stations as the congregation exits the building.
- No communion trays will be passed.
- Masks and gloves will **not** be provided, but **you are welcome to wear your own PPE** if you wish.
- Doors will be propped open so you can enter/exit without touching door handles.
- **No food or beverages** will be served in worship center or lobby.
- Seating in auditorium will be rearranged to facilitate social distancing (rows removed, groups/individuals encouraged to maintain a 3 chair distance between household groups).
- At the end of services, ushers will dismiss by rows to four available exits to help maintain social distancing.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at key locations around main building, and you are also encouraged to bring your own sanitizer if you wish.
- High contact, high traffic surfaces will be cleaned/disinfected between/before services.
