Discussion:

1. What was the most important take-away for you from this week's message?
2. What brought the Disciples to that mountain in Galilee? What prompted them to make the 3-day journey?
3. Why do you think Jesus' disciples had doubts (v. 17), even though Jesus was standing right in front of them?
4. **Application:** How does doubt show up in your own life and walk with Christ?
5. Why did Jesus speak first of his own authority? Why is that authority significant in this context?
6. **Application:** What does Jesus' authority mean to us as his disciples?

7. Explain in your own words the commission Jesus gives to his followers. What's unexpected about it? What's difficult about it?

8. **Application:** How can we be more serious about carrying out this commission, individually and as a body?

9. Why is Jesus' promise in verse 20 so important? How does it change the way we look at disciple-making?

10. Can you summarize the theological message of this text? How would you state the core message in one sentence?
