1. What is the difference between a person from an UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUP and an UNCHURCHED person?  
*(A person from an UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUP has no access to the Gospel and an UNCHURCHED person has access to the Gospel.)*
2. Why do you think 59% of our world's population still live among unreached people groups?  
*(There are many reasons but the major reasons are that unreached people groups are difficult to access because of conflict, harsh conditions, isolation, restricted governments, and religions.)*
3. What do you think of the statement, "God controls the movements of all people?" Do you think that God could be using the events of the world to give people access to the Gospel?
4. What thoughts, feelings and emotions come up when you hear the word refugee? Is it positive, negative, undecided, or concerned?
5. Leviticus 19:34 says, "The foreigner residing among you must be treated as your native-born. Love them as yourself, for you were foreigners in Egypt. I am the LORD your God." What do you think it means to treat the foreigner as your native-born? How could you personally do this?
6. What might the consequences be if we fail to see this missional opportunity or fail to act on it?  
*(The people that God has brought to our country will remain unreached because our paths don't naturally cross. We shop at different stores, live in different neighborhoods and do different activities.)*
7. John 4:35-38 says, "Don't you have a saying, 'It's still four months until harvest'? I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest. Even now the one who reaps draws a wage and harvests a crop for eternal life, so that the sower and the reaper may be glad together. Thus the saying 'One sows and another reaps' is true. I sent you to reap what you have not worked for. Others have done the hard work, and you have reaped the benefits of their labor." What do you think Jesus meant by, "Others have done the hard work"? How would you describe the "hard work" in cross-cultural ministry?
