Discussion Questions

1. Read the "Parable of the Ten Minas" that immediately precedes this passage (Lk 19:11-27). What's significant about the fact that this parable is immediately before Jesus' entry into Jerusalem?
2. How was Jesus' entry into Jerusalem a fulfillment of prophecy (Ref. Zech. 9:9-10)? How might this have informed the way the crowds received him?
3. **Apply It!** When was the last time you felt truly moved to "...rejoice and praise God...for all the mighty works [you] have seen" (v. 37)? If it's been a while, how can you regain that sense of excitement and joy at what God has done?
4. What do you think the crowds were expecting when they welcomed Jesus with such joy? What did Jesus prophesy over Jerusalem at the time (vv. 41-44)? Why?
5. What might have been surprising to the people about what Jesus did once in the city (vv. 45-48)? How might this have led to eventual disappointment with the one they called "Messiah"?
6. **Apply It!** Have you ever felt disappointed with the Lord? How do we move forward in faith when things don't turn out as planned?
