Discussion Questions

3. Why is it so important to live with "If the Lord wills" at the front of the mind? What does this do to the way we look at all of life?
4. **Apply It!** What does it look like when you are truly seeking God's will first and foremost in your decision-making?
5. Why is it difficult for us to resist "arrogant boasting" and live in dependence on God alone?
6. What does James mean when he says, "...whoever knows the right thing to do and fails to do it, for him it is sin," (v. 17)? How can we avoid this kind of sin?
7. **Apply It!** What will you do, based on this passage, to better pursue our mission - to Live for God, to Love Each Other, and to Build God's Kingdom?
