Discussion Questions

1. What does Paul warn about for those living and doing ministry in the "last days" (v.1)? Why is this warning important for us?
2. **Apply It!** Why is it important that each of us is aware/alert about what lies ahead for us as we seek to follow Jesus? What can happen if we're ignorant/unaware of danger?
3. What's notable about the list of sins/characteristics in vv. 2-5? Why didn't Paul just use a blanket term like "ungodly" or "sinful"?
4. What does it mean to "avoid such people" (v. 5)? Who are we to avoid? What does that mean?
5. **Apply It!** What can we learn from the 'case study' in verses 6 and 7? What happened to make the women in Paul's example vulnerable to deception? How can we avoid their fate?
6. How does it encourage you to know that God's enemies won't get very far (v. 9)? How does this change the way we approach these difficult last days?
7. **Apply It!** What will you do, based on this passage, to better pursue our mission - to Live for God, to Love Each Other, and to Build God's Kingdom?
