Discussion Questions

1. Why was Paul's example so important for Timothy's own life and ministry (vv. 10-13)? What did Timothy learn from following?
2. **Apply It!** Who do you 'follow'? Who provides the example for you to imitate in your own walk with Jesus? In other words, who has disciplined you as Paul disciplined Timothy?
3. Why does persecution await everyone who follows Jesus (vv. 12-13)?
4. How should Christians respond to the reality (and certainty) of persecution (see vv. 14-15)?
5. **Apply It!** How can we help each other 'continue in what [we've] learned,' especially in the midst of persecution or difficulty? What do verses 14-15 look like from a practical perspective?
6. What can you learn about God's Word from verses 16-17? What characterizes the Word? What makes it trustworthy? What does it accomplish in our lives?
7. **Apply It!** What will you do, based on this passage, to better pursue our mission - to Live for God, to Love Each Other, and to Build God's Kingdom?
