3. Why is it so dangerous for us to 'accumulate' teachers for ourselves who tell us what we want to hear (vv. 3-4)?
4. See verse 5 - what's our job as Christians?
5. **Apply It!** What does it look like to obey v. 5 in our daily lives?
6. What can we learn from Paul's example? Why do you think he writes verses 6-8 the way he does? What's he hoping to impart to Timothy (and by extension, to us)?
7. Read verses 9-18. What's the hope that Paul highlights in the midst of the difficulties he describes?
8. **Apply It!** What will you do, based on this passage, to better pursue our mission - to Live for God, to Love Each Other, and to Build God's Kingdom?
